Brief Medical History

Patient had history of RTA (Road Traffic Accident) on 29.9.2015 which led to head injury; she has been put on conservative management.

Main Medical Examination & Clinical Findings

- Patient is semi-conscious, GCS: 11/15, spontaneous breathing, stable vital signs.
- She has limb fracture, DVT, frequent central apnea and convulsions. No bed sores.

Radiological & Pathological Findings

1st CT brain: showed hemorrhagic contusions, SAH, diffuse axonal injury. Last CT: subtle subcortical high parietal hypodensities also in the brain stem mostly due to her previous insult. No hemorrhage or infarct.

Diagnosis

RTA, diffuse axonal injury, limb fracture and old DVT.

Medications and Management

- NG feeding 300ml every 3 hours
- Trimethoprim Tab 80mg OD
- Rivaroxaban Tab 20mg OD
- Na Valproate syrup 400mg TDS
- Clonazepam Tab 0.5mg TDS
- Tegretol syrup 200mg TDS
- Piracetam syrup 200mg TDS
- Zantac Tab 300mg BD
- Artificial eye drop BD
- Physiotherapy TDS

Recommendation

Patient needs rehabilitation program. Justification for management abroad: Rehabilitation center. Treatment not available in Sudan.
