History

Left eye outward deviation and smaller eye. Head injury 18 months back, was in coma at that time. No significant complaint of double vision.

Visual Acuity

Both Eyes: 6/9, N6

Intraocular Pressure (IOP)

Right: 16 mmHg, Left: 17 mmHg

Diagnosis

- Right Eye: Normal.
- Left Eye: Resolving III Cranial nerve palsy with residual ptosis and exotropia. Normal Fundus (uncooperative for periphery exam).

Prescription

- Tears-Plus / Tears Naturale II / Refresh Tears / GenTeal Eye Drops – 4 times daily if burning or irritation or dryness.
- Refresh Liquigel / GenTeal Gel Eye Drops – 4 times daily if burning or irritation or dryness.
