## Abnormal – Requiring Attention (1)

| Test        | Result    | Reference | Status | Clinical Significance  |
|-------------|-----------|-----------|--------|--|
| Cholesterol | 295 mg/dL | <200      | HIGH   | Significantly elevated. Desirable <200, Borderline 200-239, High >=240. Likely related to immobility and diet. Statin consideration if persistent. |

## Normal – Reassuring (8)

| Test               | Result     | Comment  |
|--------------------|------------|--|
| AST (GOT)          | 14 U/L     | Normal liver enzyme.   |
| ALT (GPT)          | 17 U/L     | Normal liver enzyme.   |
| Bilirubin Total    | 0.2 mg/dL  | Normal   |
| Bilirubin Direct   | 0.12 mg/dL | Normal   |
| Bilirubin Indirect | 0.1 mg/dL  | Normal   |
| Urea               | 25 mg/dL   | Normal kidney function.                                      |
| Creatinine         | 0.6 mg/dL  | At lower end of normal – consistent with sarcopenia pattern. |
| Uric Acid          | 2.9 mg/dL  | Normal   |

## Notes

Liver and kidney function tests. Notable: Cholesterol 295 mg/dL (HIGH).
